## Alumni Grant

Since 1837, Muskingum College has offered an educational experience emphasizing academic, social, and spiritual growth in a supportive but challenging environment. Over the past 165 years, some 23,000 students have benefitted from this experience, becoming part of the “long magenta line” and making significant contributions to society. As a child or grandchild of a Muskingum alum, you understand and appreciate the impact Muskingum can have and may be looking for the same positive experiences in your college search. Muskingum values its strong ties with alumni, and the Alumni Grant recognizes the importance of this relationship.

The value of the Muskingum College Alumni Grant is \$1,000 annually for each year of full-time study. Financial need is not a requirement, although the Alumni Grant is factored into the financial aid package for students demonstrating need. Upon confirmation of a student’s eligibility, the grant is credited directly to the student’s account in increments of \$500 per semester. Students must make satisfactory academic progress toward a degree in order to remain eligible.

To qualify for the Alumni grant, students must:

1. Be admitted to Muskingum College and enroll on a full-time basis.
2. Be a dependent child or grandchild of a Muskingum College alum (Muskingum defines an alum as a person who has completed at least one semester at Muskingum College).
3. Complete the enclosed Alumni Grant Information Form.

Students may qualify for more than one type of non need-based financial aid, though limitations are placed on the total amount of Muskingum-funded non need-based assistance a student may receive. These limits are outlined in provisions which accompany all scholarships and financial aid awards. Recipients of full-tuition scholarships or remissions are not eligible for the Alumni Grant.

Applicants who qualify for need-based financial aid may be eligible for assistance beyond the level of the Alumni Grant and other non need-based awards. Students planning to apply for need-based assistance must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit signed copies of parent and student federal tax forms between January 1 and March 15 of their senior year.
