

## **Legacy Grant**

Since 1837, Muskingum University has offered an educational experience emphasizing academic, social, and spiritual growth in a supportive but challenging environment. Over the years, thousands of students have benefitted from this experience, becoming part of the "long magenta line" and making significant contributions to society. Muskingum values its strong ties with alumni, and the Legacy Grant recognizes the importance of this relationship.

The value of the Muskingum University Legacy Grant is \$3,000 annually for each year of full-time study. Financial need is not a requirement, although the Legacy Grant is factored into the financial aid package for students demonstrating need. Upon confirmation of a student's eligibility, the grant is credited directly to the student's account in increments of \$1,500 per semester.

To qualify for the Legacy Grant, students must:

- 1. Be admitted to Muskingum University as a full-time traditional undergraduate student.
- 2. Have one of the following Legacy connections:
  - Be the dependent child or grandchild of a former Muskingum University student who has completed at least two years/four semesters at Muskingum University
  - Be the sibling of a former Muskingum University student who has completed at least two years/four semesters at Muskingum University
  - Be the sibling of a current Muskingum University student who is a dependent of the same parents.
- 3. Complete the enclosed Legacy Grant Information Form or indicate your legacy connection on the application for admission.

Students may qualify for more than one type of non-need-based financial aid, though limitations are placed on the total amount of Muskingum-funded non-need-based assistance a student may receive. These limits are outlined in provisions which accompany all scholarships and financial aid awards. Recipients of full-tuition scholarships or remissions are not eligible for the Legacy Grant.

Applicants who qualify for need-based financial aid may be eligible for assistance beyond the level of the Legacy Grant and other non-need-based awards. Students planning to apply for need-based assistance should file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) between October 1 and March 15 of their senior year.
