
Dr. Manley, in his first year has become a vibrant part of Muskingum; not only at the administrative level but also at the personal level.






The purpose of any college is to prepare one for his adult life. Included in this preparation is the opportunity to socialize and enjoy life with one's fellow man.










































































































Trustees Approve N

The Social Regulations Committee was formed about two years ago, composed of students, faculty, and members of the Board of Trustees. This organization, headed on campus by Dr. Fisk, worked for almost one and a half years to prepare a recommendation concerning many areas of the campus regulations. Community

tees enacted a new social policy the recommendation before passing proval. Last spring the faculty reviewed the regulations and endorsed them by a majority vote. The document was then examined by the Board of Trustees at a summer session. The issue was tabled for further discussion at the October 15 meeting.

On October 15 the Board of Trustees made this recommendation official college policy. Reprinted here is the new, approved so-Council, the forerunner of the cial policy of Muskingum College:

Smoking Regulation

Muskingum College has traditionally limited campus areas where smoking is permitted. The President of the College shall be authorized to designate smoking areas at his discretion. The President shall attempt to eliminate inconsistencies in current smoking

Standards of Student Personal Behavior

When a student enrolls at Mus-

his personal responsibility to uphold the honor and ideals of the College in all areas of College life and in the maintenance of standards of personal behavior.

Believing that the effects of drinking alcoholic beverages can be both physically and emotionally harmful, and that these effects often produce irresponsible behavior, Muskingum College affirms that such practice is incompatible with its ideals. Baseball 1965


The 1965 Muskie baseball team, a victim of several one-run decisions, compiled only a 3—14—0 record on the diamond. The final game was but another heartbreaker as the Muskies were defeated by Ohio Wesleyan, Conference Champs, by a lone run.

Joe Arganbright, the mainstay of our pitching corps for four years, led our mound staff again and compiled a 1.53 earned-run average although his record was 1—4. Arganbright was also the leading swatter with a batting average of .298. Our team was plagued by weak hitting throughout the season. Two other leading hitters were Dick Bassetti and Doug Welsh.

With an experienced team, a new outlook, and a new coach, Mr. Robert Stokes, the '66 season promises diamond excitement and victory.

With over half of the lettermen returning, the '66 season should make up for some of 1965's bad breaks.



SEASON

In the beginning, the goal of the 1965 edition of the Fighting Muskies was the Ohio Conference Championship. They were ultimately destined to achieve that pinnacle, but not before countless hours of wearying practice had elapsed up on "the Hill." The actual difficulty of the challenge facing the team is best summed up by the words of Ed Sherman, "This years schedule is one of the toughest ever to confront a Muskie team." The first part of the season was characterized by exciting, low scoring, Muskingum victories. The chief factor in these wins was the brilliant teamwork of a defensive team that allowed only 40 points to be scored against them over a nine game span. As the season neared its end, the offense finally proved its championship caliber as offense and defense blended to smash Denison's Big Red 35-0. This victory won the Ohio Conference Football Championship for the Muskies. Over the full season, consistently outstanding players were Carl Lambert, Steve Aller, Tom Dillard, Mark DeVilling, and Captain Bruce Rohrer on defense, with Doug Smart and Rick Harbold outstanding on offense. Muskingum was well represented on the all-Conference teams as they placed 8 players on either the first or second team. Those selected to the first team are Mark DeVilling, Tom Dillard, Steve Aller, Charles Harrigan, and Doug Smart, while those on the second team are Bruce Rohrer, Carl Lambert, and Rick Harbold.




Homecoming 1965


Swimming 1966
