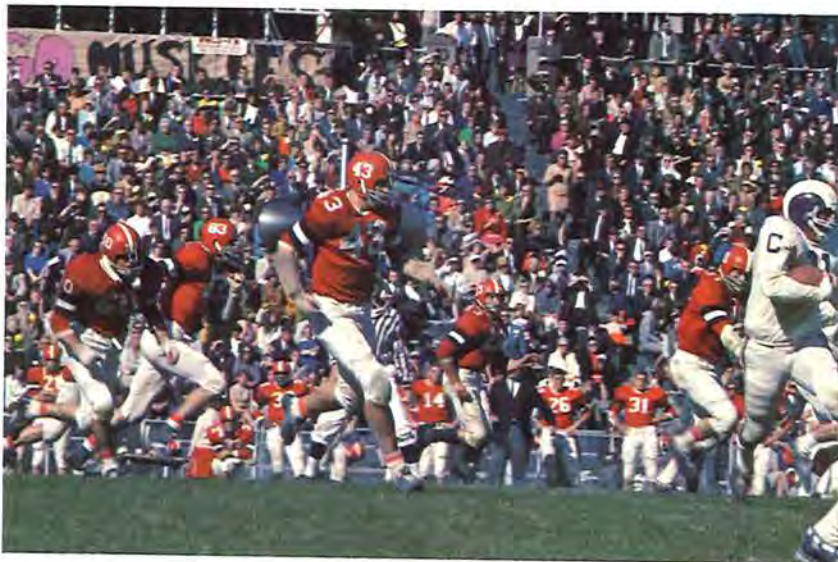


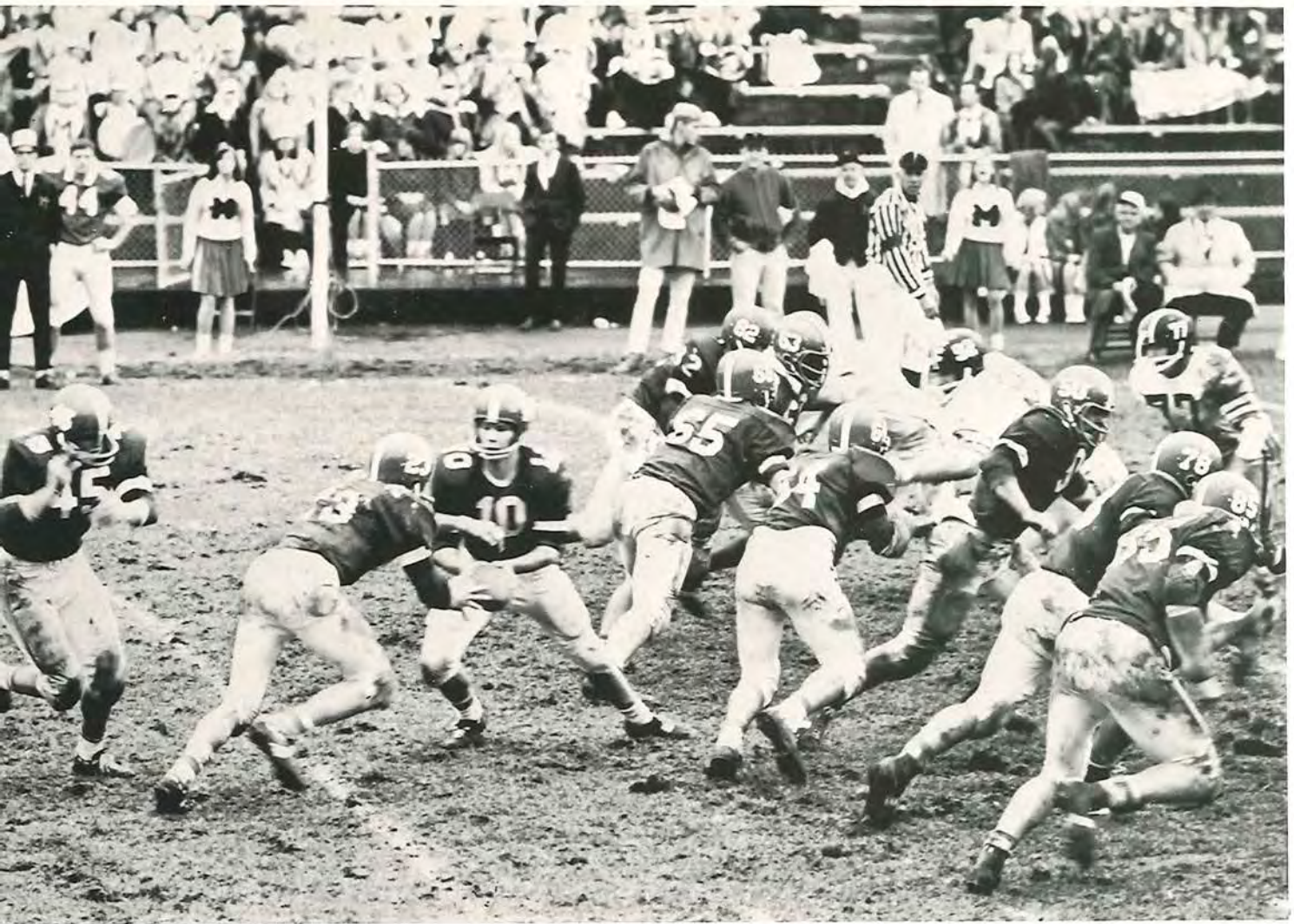
Muskingum's football is based on a winning tradition that stretches back to the years before the turn of the century. With this tremendous traditional vigor, a comparable pride has developed a winning machine that has compiled in the past few years a won—lost record that ranks with the best small colleges in the nation. Twice in the past four years Muskingum has placed teams in the Grantland Rice Bowl, while last year's team represented one of the best that Muskingum has ever fielded—7th in the nation with 9-0 record. It would have been hard to surpass the previous successes, but in many ways the 1967 team succeeded in adding its pages to the football legacy here at Muskingum.

The season began with a game that had been talked about in the Ohio Conference for years. It had been billed as the game of the decade in the Ohio Conference and the premier game that week for Ohio colleges. It was the baptism by fire for Muskingum's new coach Bob Stokes, who replaced Ed Sherman and his fantastic 22 year record. It was also a time of trying new defensive personnel and the proving of a tried offense. Even though Muskingum came out on the short end of the 21-0 score, the points did not reflect how really closely the game was contested.

The week after the Wittenberg game was not a very happy one, but it saw a period of hard work and strong leadership from the seniors. The next Saturday's results reflected what many people thought could not be done, a 53-7 victory over Otterbien. Muskingum was now on a comeback that was to show their fans that Muskingum teams do not quit even if they lose the big game. After two fine victories of 12-0 over Mt. Union and 10-3 over a highly talented and hard hitting Hiedelberg team, the stage was set for the battle on Homecoming Day with a good team from Capital.

The day was perfect and the game matched two teams with identical records; Muskingum leading the league in rushing offense, against Capital leading the league in rushing defense. The game was played evenly in the first half until the closing seconds when the Uszynski to Harbold pass combination clicked for a great last second touchdown that gave Muskingum the momentum to win 34-14.

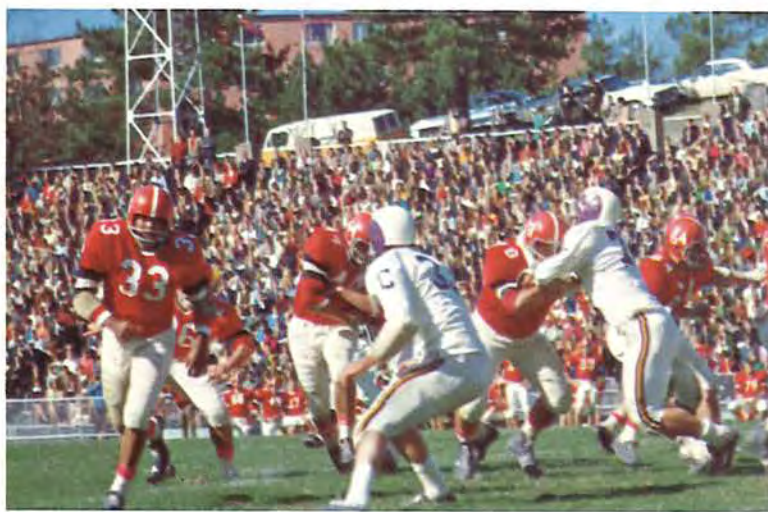


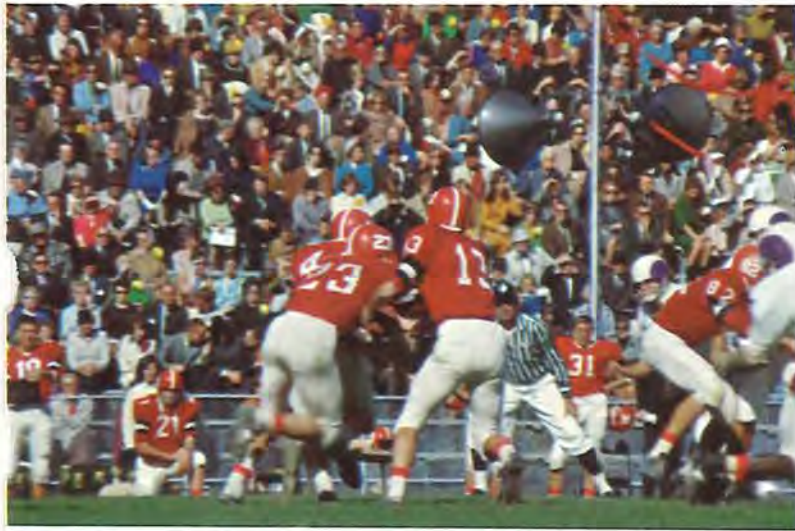
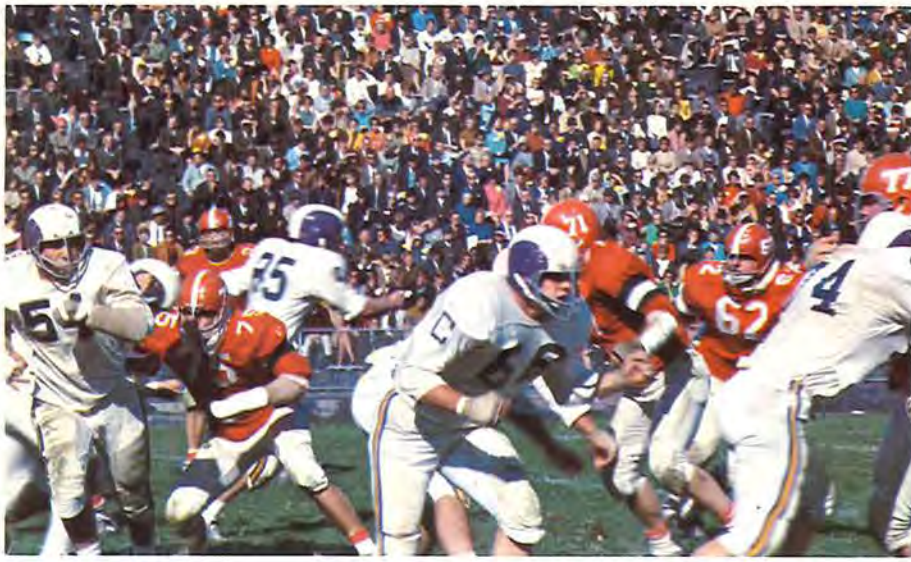




The mid-season slump was reached the next week at Ohio Northern. While the Muskies were looking forward their next two opponents, Denison and Hofstra, they eked out a 17-6 win over the unusually tough Polar Bears. The traditional rivalry between Denison and Muskingum is well known in the Ohio Conference. This year was to prove no different, as both teams came into the contest with identical records. The Muskies deserved a well-earned victory 14-7 in a game that saw all the scoring done in the first half. However, the next week was to see the greatest victory of the season. The defensive team which had been improving all season finally came into its own against Hofstra who was nationally ranked and under consideration for a bowl berth. The 12-9 victory was considered one of the greatest victories that Muskingum has had in years. The season was then capped by a trip to upstate New York and a 21-6 victory over Hobart College.

In the lobby of John Glenn gymnasium there hang many pictures of Muskie championship teams. Some are undefeated and some have had 8-1 seasons similar to the 1967 season. In fact in the four years that the present seniors have attended Muskingum, the Muskies have compiled a record of 33-3 in regular season games and have attended two post-season bowl games. This year three seniors were on the all Ohio Conference team offense—Dave Gradwohl, Doug Smart, and Rick Harbold; and four men on defense—Jim Heacock, Todd Henderson, Greg Freda, and Dave Heimerl. Fred Herdman was named to the second team offense, while Rick Harbold was named for the second straight year to the Mike Gregory award for the most valuable player in the Ohio Conference. The 1967 football season started in defeat but ended in a victorious eight wins in a row and a second place in the Ohio Conference standings.

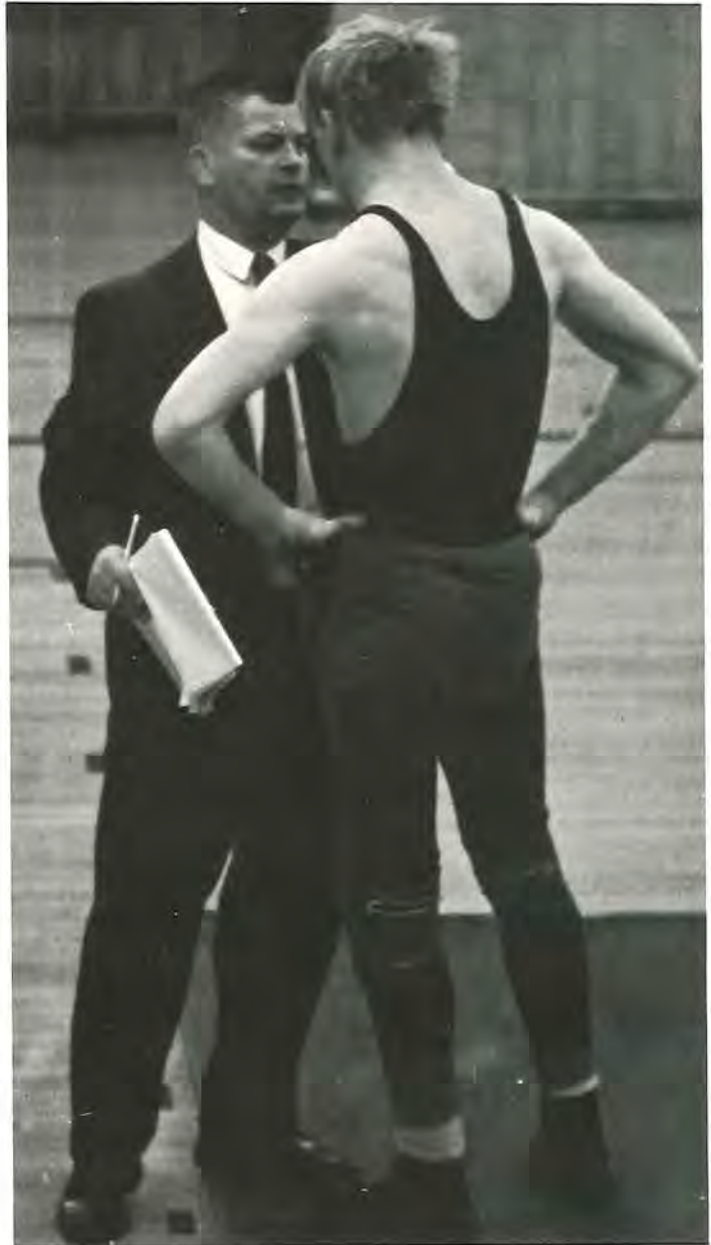

It has been many years since Muskingum wrestling has had such a good season. Wrestling at Muskingum has never been a very powerful sport, but in the past few years under the coaching of Les Baum the team has shown a marked improvement from losing seasons, to even records, and finally culminating in this season's strong performance.

This year the season must be characterized as one of close matches and close meets. A reason for this phenomenon might have been the great overall balance of the Conference; but whatever the reason, the Muskingum grapplers fought hard for well deserved victories. In individual records of the various weight classes, there were more ties than ever before. These ties account in part for the closeness of many of the matches—five of the meets were won by five points or less.

The stalwarts of the team were the seniors: Bruce Bridenbaker, Bob Stewart, Maury Wilber, and Jim Caniglia. Special praise must go to heavyweight Jim Caniglia, who was the deciding factor in most of the close matches when the difference between victory and defeat came down to whether he pinned or decisioned his man. Much of the credit for wrestling's strong season lies with the freshmen who filled very capably some of the team's weaker weight classes.
