The decade of the 70's will make difficult demands of both individuals and institutions as they work to meet the challenges of an environment embodying constant change. Muskingum as a restless church-related college will not be exempt. What meaning does this carry for the college and its people? This means Muskingum has an institutional obligation to the past as well as to the present and future generations. Although Muskingum must keep the long-range flow of the institution in view, it must at the same time carry on a continuous search for modes and means whereby each student has more opportunities to find out what is meaningful to him as a person. Expressed in more specific terms, the college must ask such "redemptive questions" as "What is the nature of man?" and "What is the human good?" The college must constantly examine the application of such human values as honesty, truth and openness as seen and experienced through interpersonal campus life. The college as an institution must continuously strive for a more genuine campus community in which easygoing relationships are common among constituencies of the campus. Institutional resources must be allocated out of a belief that the college, as an organism is more than the sum of its parts. It requires the college to assume a greater responsibility in making possible each student's active involvement in some public service, an experience which should be an integral part of the formal credit, course load system. It means the college tries to help the student become more aware first that there are moral and ethical implications involved in substantive concepts, and further, that these implications should be considered by the student. It means each student, faculty, staff or trustee is obligated to achieve more of an institution-wide perspective of Muskingum. It requires of each Muskingum constituency a useful role in problem solving, in having some influence on the decision-making process.

Muskingum must aim to graduate people who are both capable of and willing to contribute to society, to improve the human condition. Muskingum must try to maximize the learning capacity of each student and must more realistically define its own institutional limits and goals.

It is my belief that the Class of 1970 has helped make Muskingum a stronger college. It is my hope that the Class of 1970 as alumni will help Muskingum better achieve its goals and realize its expectations. Peace.

INDIANS BOW, 35-7

Finish in Deadlock for League Crown With Tigers and Yale

PRINCETON, N. J., Nov. 22—Princeton's football team laid claim most emphatically to one-third of the Ivy League championship today by routing previously unbeaten Dartmouth, 25-7. No matter how stunning the upset, though, the Tigers must share the crown with the Indians as well as Yale, all of whom won six and lost one in league play.

The improving Tigers eleven, which started the season by losing to Rutgers, 29-0, and to Cornell and Colgate and Yale,

gave the Green no quarter today and was by far the superior team. Dartmouth seemed tense and played its poorest contest of the year.

Three monumental mistakes by the Green in the first half gave Princeton a foot in the door, and the Tigers never let it shut. Led by John Bjorklund, sophomore halfback starting the second game, and by Scott McBean, the senior quarterback, they cashed in each opportunity to virtually clinch the game by rolling up a 21-0 half-lead.

Quick Kick Backfires
In the first quarter, when the teams performed like boxers giving each other's style and led six punts, Dartmouth's Mikear attempted a quick kick. But the ball slithered off the side of his foot for 16 yards, giving Princeton possession on the Green 34. Bjorklund, on steady 5-yard gains, mostly on power sweeps around and inside his ends, carried the ball across for the first of his three touchdowns.

It was only the second time Dartmouth had been behind a year and Jim Chasey, the senior's fine junior quarterback, immediately started his typical drives after two first downs, eluding pursuers at speed, tried to loft a 40-yard pass over the Princeton safety's head. The ball traveled 30 yards but Jeffrey Davis intercepted. After it had bounced off an defender. For Chasey, it marked the beginning of a long, productive afternoon, one he certainly had not been accustomed to.

YALE TEAM VICTOR OVER HARVARD, 7-0

Martin's 36-Yard Run in 3d Period Paves Way for Score in Hard-Fought Battle

NEW HAVEN, Nov. 22—Yale beat Harvard as expected today, but had an unexpectedly hard time doing so. The Elis' only score in the 7-0 victory came when the desultory game was two-thirds over. The winners then had to survive a brief fourth-period threat by Harvard, which had the Yale partisans in the crowd of 62,562 thinking back in horror to a year ago when the Crimson tied the unbeaten and favored Elis in the final seconds, 29-29, and thus shared the Ivy championship with them.

But there was no horror tale this time. Yale wound up sharing the title again, only this time it came as a delight and surprise. Princeton's upset of undefeated Dartmouth carved the title in three parts as the Tigers, the Green and the Elis all finished with 6-1 won-lost records. It was only the second time the championship had been shared three ways, the other

Columbia Scores Over Brown, 18-3, As Sefcik Excels

PROVIDENCE, R. I., Nov. 22—For the first time this season, Columbia's thick-skinned football fans were able to walk out of a stadium today humming "Roar Lion Roar." The occasion was an 18-3 victory over Brown, a surprise success that enable the Lions to avoid finishing with their worst record ever. A loss would have meant a won-lost mark of 0-9, and no previous Columbia team had lost that many. Instead, Coach Frank Navarro's squad wound up with an over-all record of 1-8, and a 1-6 Ivy League that gives Brown an unwanted share of last place. Today the Lion roared particularly well on defense, intercepting four passes and recovering two fumbles.

A couple of sophomores, John Sefcik and Bill Flynn, led the way offensively as Columbia gained their first-Ivy League triumph away from home since 1963. Sefcik, a 5-foot-7-inch 155-pound tailback from Youngstown, Ohio, scored both touchdowns, on runs of 17 and 3 yards. Flynn, the quarterback, completed 13 of 20 passes and directed an inspired attack that

CORNELL VICTOR OVER PENN, 28-14

Marinaro Scores All 4 Big Red Touchdowns and Sets Ivy Rushing Record

PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 22—Cornell's Ed Marinaro warmed up with 20 pull-ups in the locker room today, then wrapped up his bid for the National Collegiate rushing championship with a sizzling performance on a cold day. The Big Red sophomore, breaking the Ivy League rushing record, ran for 181 yards and scored all four touchdowns as Cornell coasted past Penn, 28-14.

Marinaro, who started the day in second place in the rushing race, raised his season total to 1,409 yards, giving him at least a temporary lead over Clarence Davis of Southern California and Steve Owens of Oklahoma. His dominance of the game was obvious. On Cornell's four scoring drives, Marinaro accounted for 45 of 62 yards (including 11 yards with a pass he caught), 35 of 46, 28 of 50 and 36 of 53. With the Eastern Division title of the American Football League still not secure, the Jets will oppose the Cincinnati Bengals today at Shea Stadium. The Jets are an 8-point betting favorite. The first-place Jets hold a two-game lead over the Houston Oilers in the division race, but the schedule threatens their grip. Unless the Jets improve not only their pass defense, but also their scoring explosiveness, they appear to be in jeopardy against the Bengals and against the Oakland Raiders next Sunday at Shea. trip to the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, Calif.

The architect of college football's upset of the year was Glenn (Bo) Schembechler, a 39-year-old coach, in his first season at Michigan. Ironically, Schembechler had spent five years as a graduate assistant and line coach under Woody Hayes, the Ohio State mentor.

After the game, excited Michigan players carried the hated Schembechler across the synthetic Tartan playing surface on their shoulders, while ecstatic students and fans rushed onto the field in scenes reminiscent of Shea Stadium. Fortunately, they had no turf to tear up for treasures.

Ohio State's defeat throws the national championship picture into turmoil, with three major teams still unbeaten, Penn State (9-0), Texas (8-0) and Arkansas (8-0). Texas and Arkansas meet Dec. 6, but a definitive national champion may not be truly determined until after the postseason bowl games are played.
