THE BOOK: Why did you accept the presidency after previously saying you would not?

DR. MILLER: I did not have any personal ambitions to be a college president . . . I like Muskingum and want to serve the college in anyway the trustees and faculty feel that I should serve it . . . I did not seek the presidency and I said that if I had wanted the job I should not have accepted the acting president position. I felt such an action would be a limiting factor with the selection committee . . . after much discussion by the selection committee, a number of students and faculty talking with me, I was persuaded that if the position were to be offered to me I should accept it. It was the attitude on the campus at the time that I felt caused me to change my mind.

T.B.: What do you want for the future of M.C.?

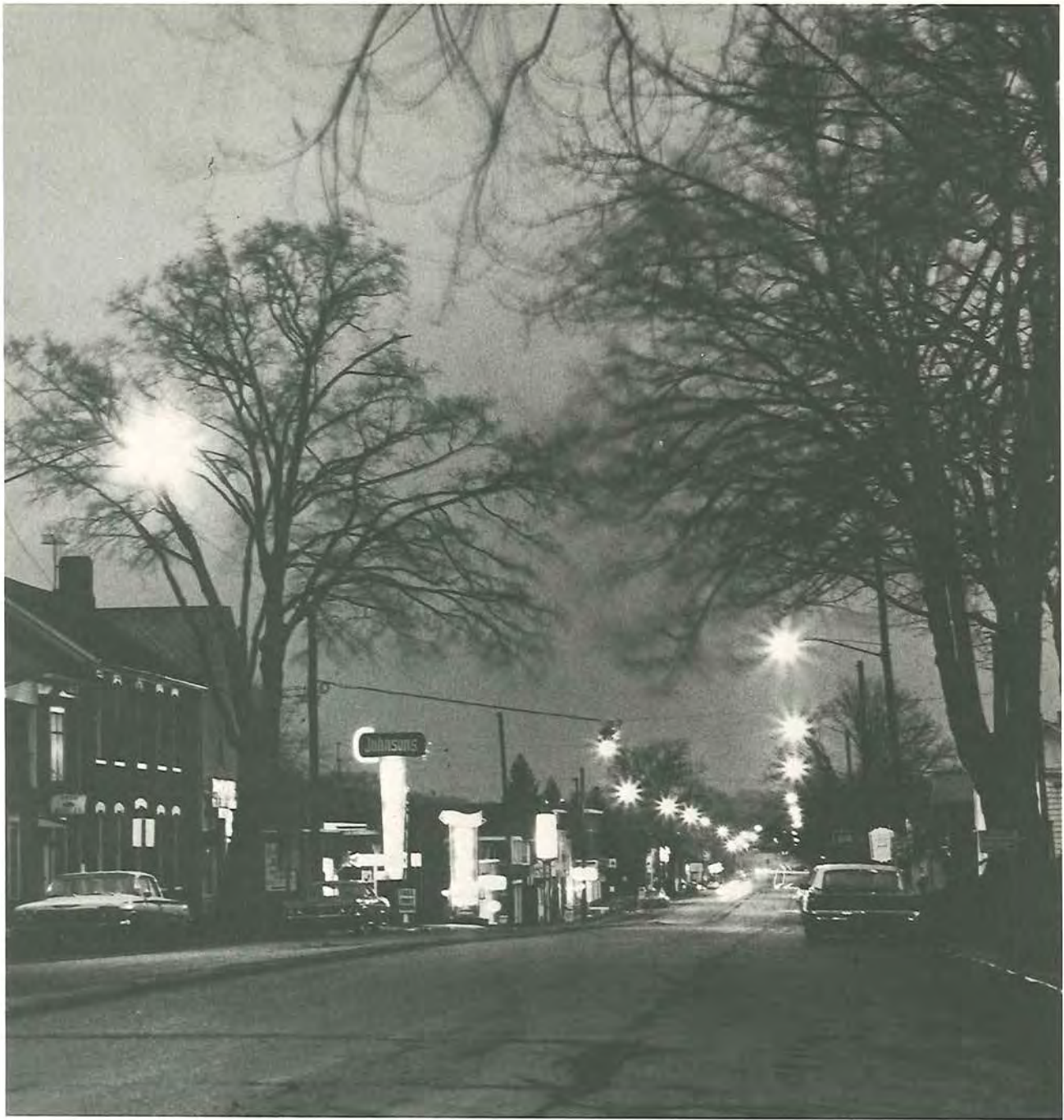
MILLER: One of the things I hope for is to improve the facilities for the teaching tools . . . we need the arts center and the library addition very badly, I list these as high priority . . . I agree that other things are needed too,



but not as basically as the facilities for the arts and also the expansion of the library. If the arts center and library addition are built, we will improve the academic appearance of the campus 100%. I feel confident that if we can build these our survival is guaranteed.

T.B.: How much in question is our survival?

MILLER: Our survival is only questioned by being a private college. These are people who say that with the inflated costs, 50% of the colleges are not going to make it . . . at the rate our costs have gone up in the 60s, we will reach \$5,000 per year before 1980 . . . how many people can afford private schools that are going to cost \$20,000 or more for an education? If costs go up then we must increase financial aid to students or the government must provide money that will follow the student at a public or private institution; I am greatly in favor of the last philosophy . . . We are now talking about a plan that would help to reduce the cost . . . it is called "continuous education" . . . it would provide a financial incentive for a student to graduate in three years and three summers . . . we would not increase the cost of summer school and we would discount the cost each year a student returned in the fall semester. This would also help to keep students at M.C. for the length of their education. But, it is not only education that inflates the cost, non-academic services contribute to the increase and we must be careful to decide which services can be justified financially . . . I am fully convinced that we are in the education business and that we have a marketing job to do. We must market Muskingum to prospective students . . . education management is a business kind of management, decisions don't come easily; there are risks involved the same as there are risks involved in any private business . . . but we are not just sitting back and seeing what will happen to M.C. . . . we are attacking the problem of being a small, private college in the 70's and we are attacking these problems vigorously.

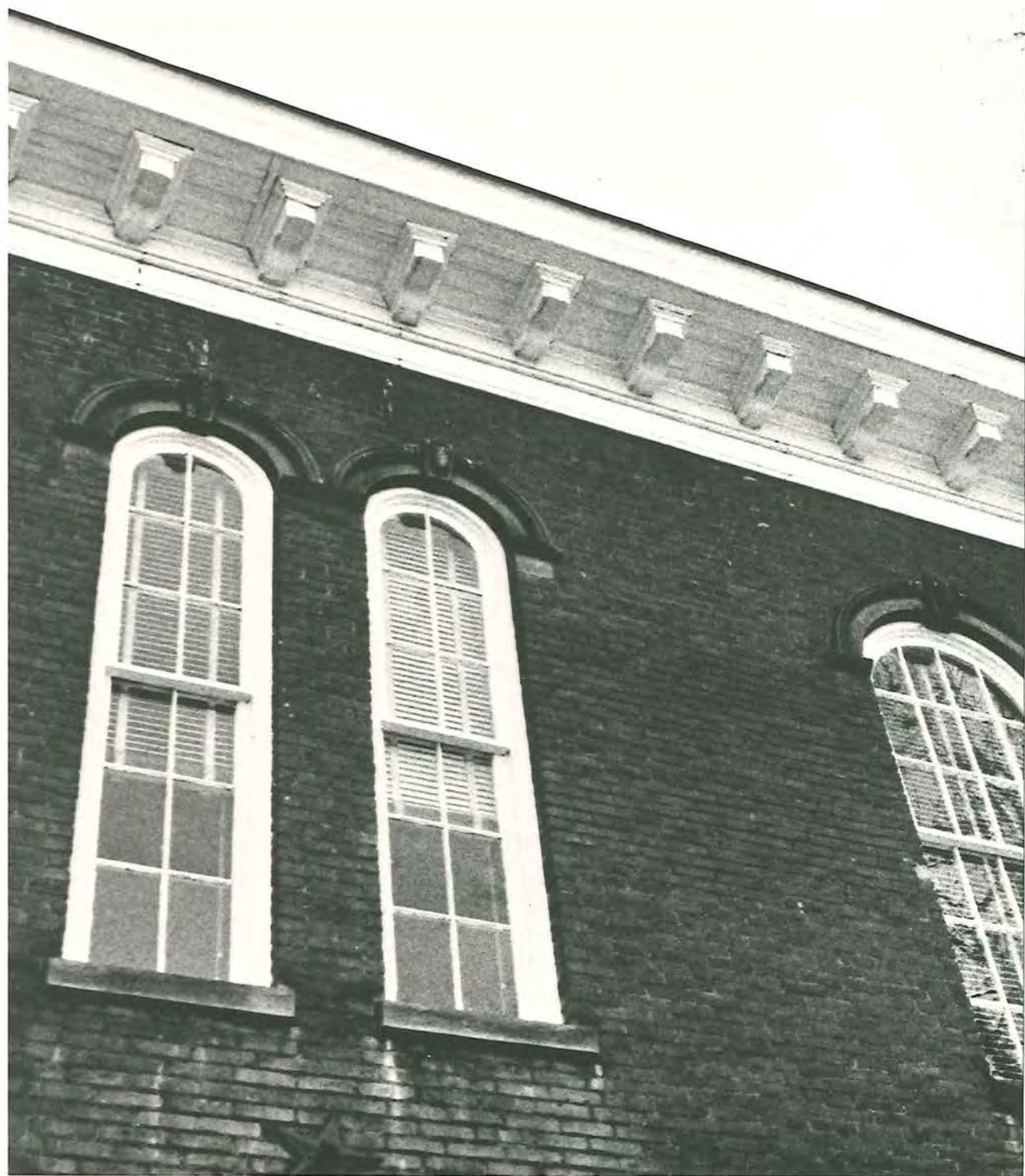


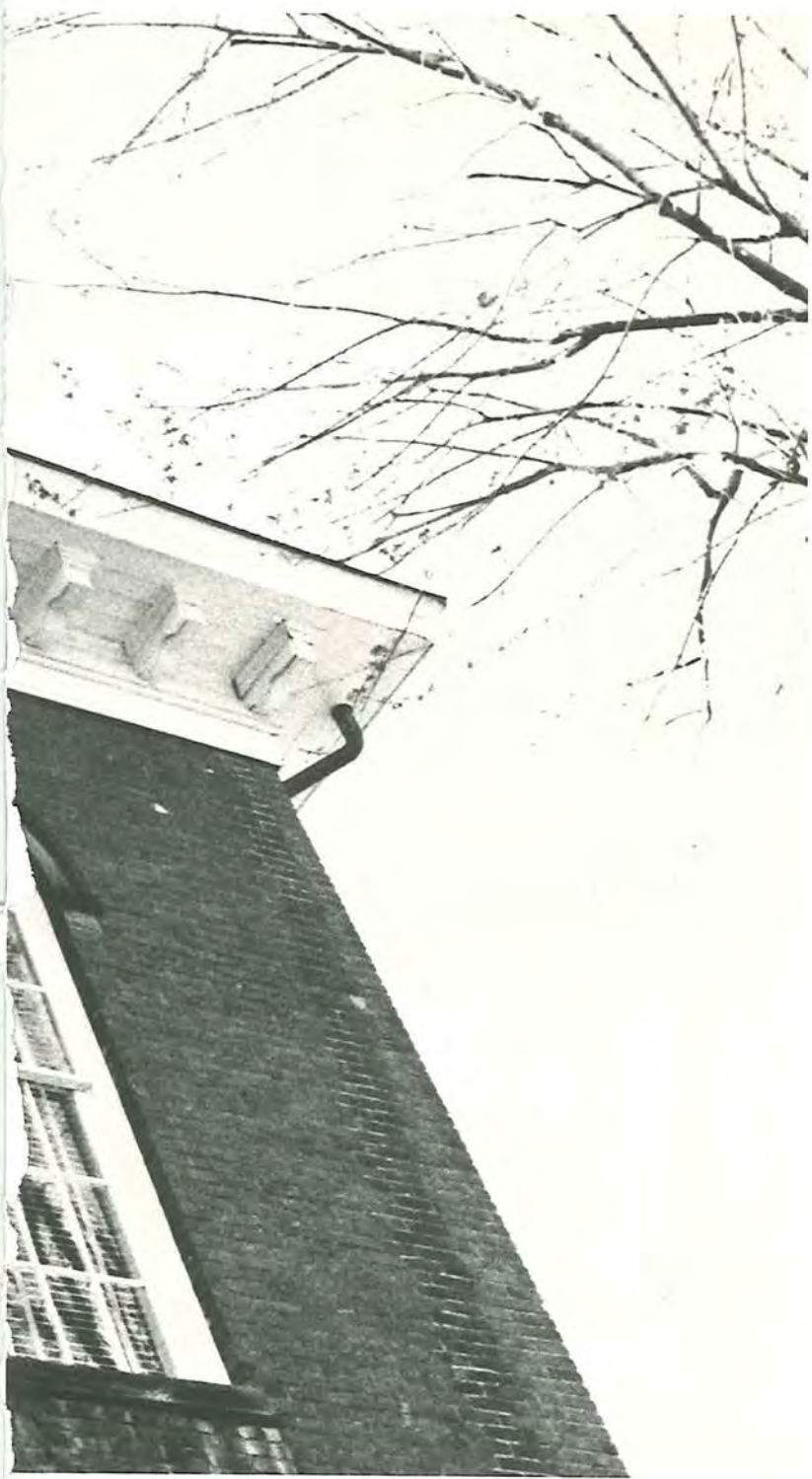

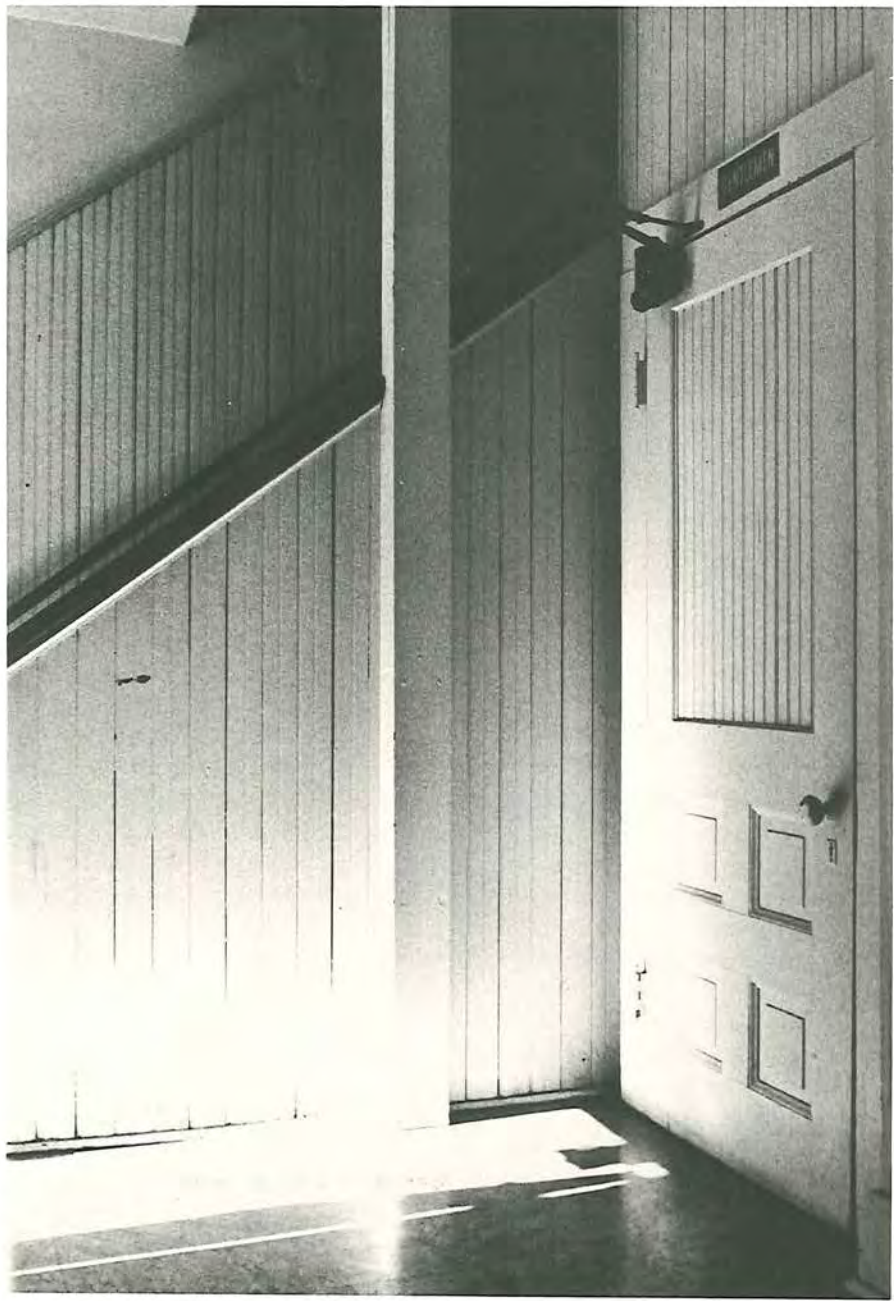












little theatre

The old actor, sitting in his easy chair and smoking a pipe, picked up the yellowed photograph lying beside him. The photo was on top of a large stack of newspaper clippings and other photos. It showed him dying the "heroic death" as twenty enemy swordsmen converged on him. He couldn't remember the name of the play, but he knew the names of every member in the cast. He had played a Spanish nobleman who saved his king from the attacking Moors, but was killed after leading a daring counter-attack against the enemy. Looking at the picture, he recalled the death scene. He had sent ten of the evil Moors to their graves before one of the bloody cowards had gotten him from behind. He remembered the tears in the eyes of the audience as he gave his final line, "God save our land from tyranny" and heard the groans as he collapsed on the ground. It had been a great tragedy and one woman in the third row was so overcome that she fainted and had to be carried out of the theatre.

Once again he was backstage accepting the congratulations from the rest of the cast. It had been a good performance and he knew many people would be outside waiting to see him. He took his time. Dressing slowly, he felt the loss all actors feel after completing a show. The feeling comes when an actor realizes his work of art has been completed and no permanent evidence of it exists. He sat at the make-up table and carefully removed the grease-paint from his face. Now, out of costume and free of make-up, he became himself again. Outside, he was disappointed to see only six people waiting to see him. One by one he accepted their congratulations and saw the gratefulness in their eyes. His friend Jack came up to him and put a hand on his shoulder. He told him it was one helluva performance and this pleased the actor because Jack knew what good theatre was. Jack was a writer for the local paper and had once been the theatre critic for a large eastern paper. If Jack thought a performance was good, it was good.

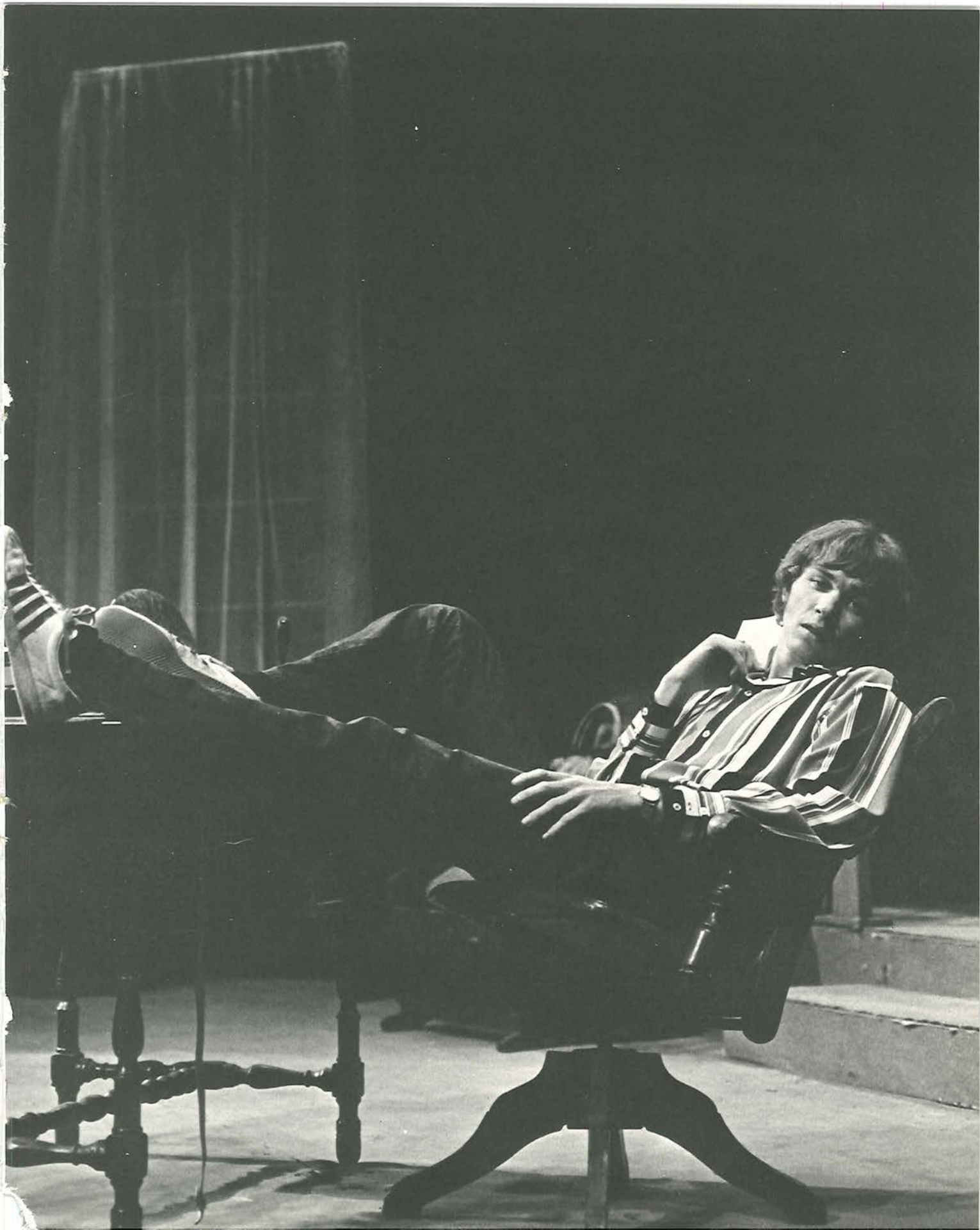
Back again, the old actor laid the photograph down and picked up a torn newspaper clipping praising his effort in another production. He smiled knowing all the reviews were good. He never had a poor review. He had been a good actor and could have been a great one but never got the chance. And now it was gone, never to return.

He looked across the room at an empty chair where many of his friends had sat. Most of his friends had been actors who traveled with him around the country playing before packed audiences every night. But they were all dead now. Even the audience that saw him perform were probably dead. And soon he would die, leaving nothing but a stack of old photographs and news clippings.

"Have patience with the jealousies and petulances of actors" he said aloud, "for their hour is their eternity." It was a quote he heard many years ago that always fascinated him. The phrase "hour of eternity" confused him because he had lived his "hour of eternity" many years ago and he wasn't sure if that hour was eternal. He laughed and said, "An artist can't explain the reasons behind his creativity and doesn't need to." This was true he thought, it had to be true.

He picked up another news clipping and carefully read his name circled in red ink. That had been a good show too. In fact, one critic said that he was one of the country's most promising young actors. He smiled and thought of those days, but secretly wondered if it had all been worth it.

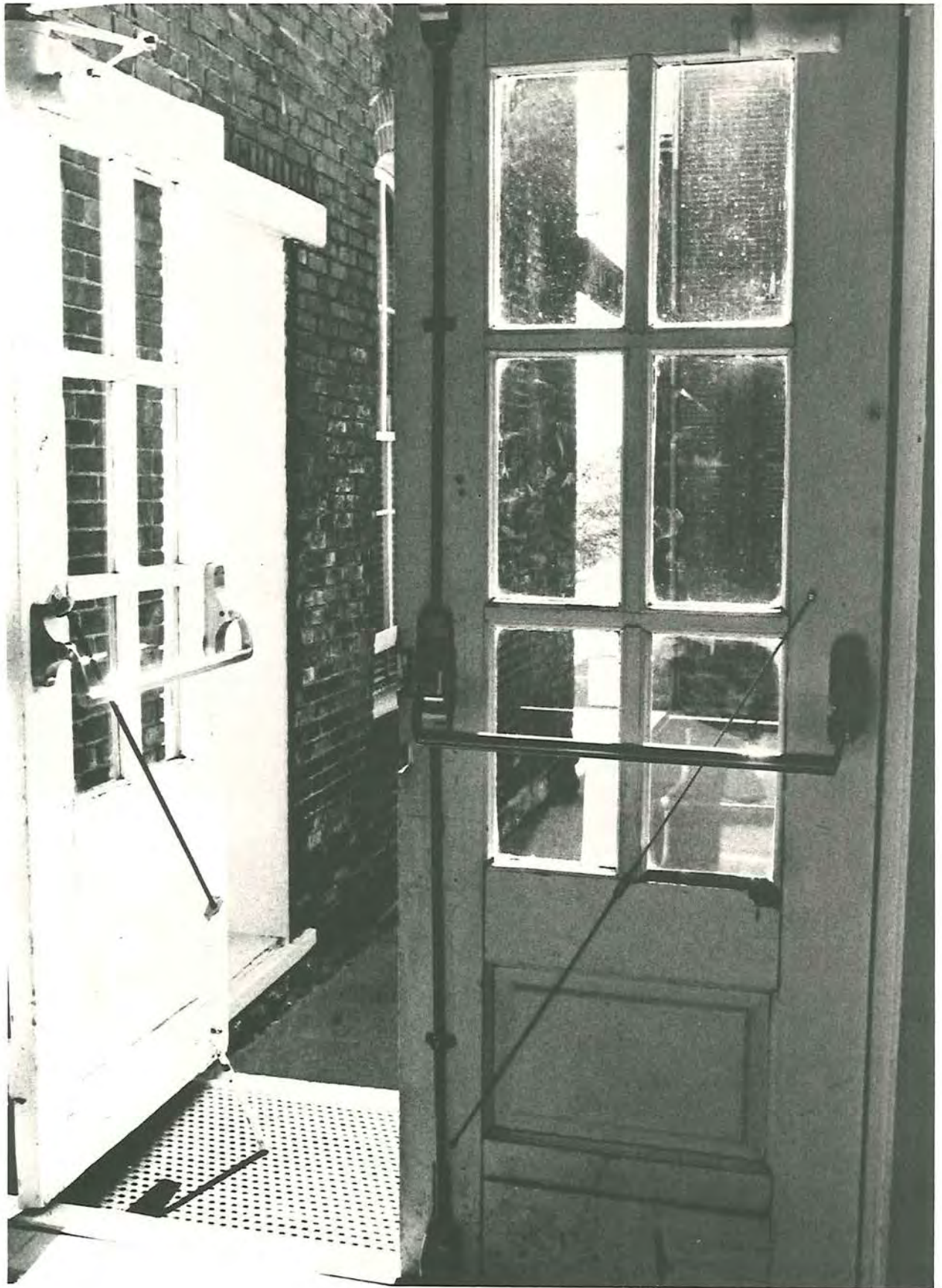
















UHURU:
