The offspring of two political candidates made Muskingum a stop on their Presidential campaign tours. Jeff Carter, son of the Democratic Presiden-

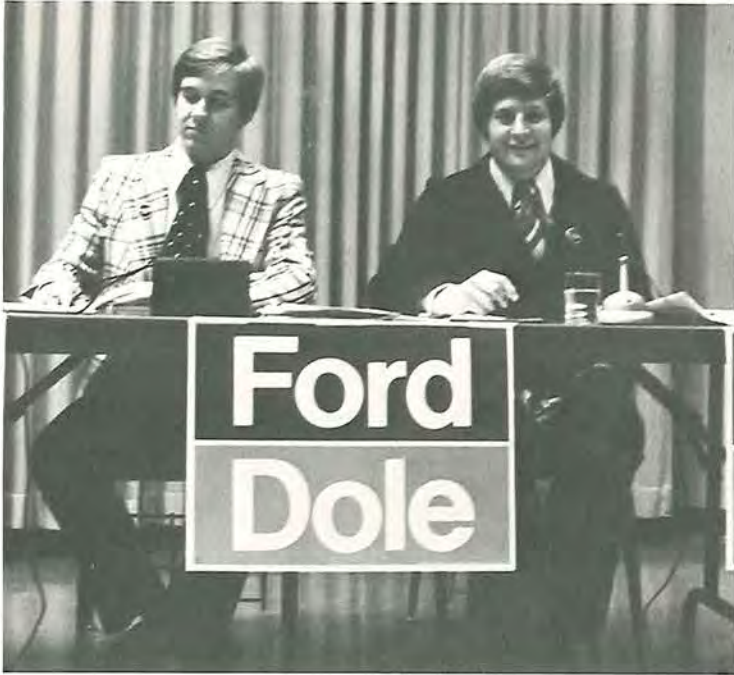
